Buttercup is situated right in the middle of the Med Quad area of Bristo Square. Built from containers with horseshoe-shaped seating, it forms a very intimate space with the audience all around.

An extremely comfortable, elegant space, Cowbarn (aka Reid Concert Hall) sits next to the bustling Bristo Square. With wonderful acoustics and a large raised stage, this space is an excellent environment for ambitious, mid-to-large scale performances, including comedy, theatre, musicals, cabaret and dance.

Stage and Seating	Cowbarn has an end-on stage which is raised about 70cm higher than the front row of the audience. The performance space is W 6m x D 4m. However, the stage is wider than this to allow for wing space on the stage left side and has a backstage cross-over. Access is via a set of treads coming off the front edge of the stage, and backstage from stage right.
Lighting	The venue will provide: - Six area front light: a combination of ETC Source4s and ETC Colour source profiles - Back light: Martin Rush PAR2s - Lighting desk: ETC Ion - Stage power: 4x 13A single phase supplies - A haze machine positioned stage left.
	Companies may be able to add specials to the rig, but these needs should be discussed with us in advance

Located in Edinburgh University's Medical School building, this room, usually used as a lecture theatre, is transformed during August into a wonderfully comfortable 196 seat end-on performance space. It's an extremely flexible, intimate space with great sight lines.

Stage and Seating	The stage has dimensions of W4.3m x D3.6m, raised at a height of 900mm from the floor. The seating rake goes from the level of the stage up towards the back of the room. There are small wings of either side of the stage with an entrance from the dressing room to stage right.

Our largest venue at the Fringe, McEwan Hall is a magnificent building and a wonderful performance space. With a large stage and extensive technical capabilities, this is a space that can hold ambitious productions that will excite and amaze audiences.

Capacity is 1000 seats, the majority of which are positioned on a seating rake stretching up from the floor level to two upper levels, where more rows of seats are situated. Tech control position is based on the second balcony.

Stage and Seating

Performance space: W12m x D7m at a height of roughly 1300mm from the audience level; this depth is the deepest part of the stage since it has a curved front. The sides of stage will have drape legs to create wing spaces and allow for side entrances. The rear of the stage will be black drape, and there will be a backstage crossover, although it is very narrow. The DSR&L corners of the stage have truss legs, with further stage masking extending outwards to cover the wings. The stage surface will be matt black marley dance floor up to the edge of the wings.

Set, Props, Costume Storage, Backstage, & Dressing Rooms


Dressing room space will be provided with tables, lights and mirrors. These are located backstage in a dedicated area, with easy access to stage. Some dressing rooms may be located in a building nearby.


Storage space for set and props is located at the back of the wings; space is limited and shared with a busy festival schedule of companies, so planned at the discretion of the venue stage manager. Please inform us of all your storage requirements so appropriate arrangements can be made.




Lighting	The venue will provide an open-white, generic general cover wash suitable to the end-on stage configuration. In addition to this a full stage colour wash will be provided by way of LED moving lights, paired with LED profile moving lights. - Control will be by an ETC ION or similar - Haze machines will be provided to cover the stage - Stage power can be provided in the form of 2 x 13A 1ph supplies. - Companies may be able to add specials to the rig but these needs should be discussed and planned in advance.
<u>Sound</u>	The PA will be a D&B rig designed to cover the full auditorium with additional Subs, and four monitor wedges. Control will be by a Midas Pro1 desk. Four channels of radio mics with both headset and handheld mics will be provided as standard, along with playback from a machine running QLab 4. The acoustics of the hall are improved through the lowering of a false drape ceiling to create a more intimate performance space.





Deep in the heart of Underbelly Cowgate, Belly Button is a mid-scale black box, end-on space with a flat stage and fully raked seating. The stage provides some off-stage space for entrances and quick-changing. Excellent for comedy, theatre, physical comedy, and musicals.

Stage and Seating	The stage is 3.6m deep, 5.5m wide, and 0.16m high. There will be some small off-stage space for prop storage or costume changes. The seating is end-on and fully raked. The Udderbelly is Underbelly's purpose-built venue inside an enormous upside-down purple cow which has been a focal point of the Edinburgh Fringe since 2006. This is the most talked about and most photographed venue of the Fringe. An exciting performance space that seats 410 in three raked seating banks on three sides. Perfect for a wide range of large-scale productions.

The Udderbelly stage is a fixed shallow thrust configuration with audience seated on three sides. The performance space is around 8.5m wide by 4.8m deep. The stage surface itself is black painted 18mm MDF laid onto the venue floor so there is a slight lip defining the fire lane between audience and stage space. The auditorium has a capacity of 410. Please refer to the Stage and plans at the end of this document. **Seating** At the rear of the stage are a pair of black drapes with a split to the centre to allow for entrances or to open up to reveal the guest truss; a triangular truss on motors used to hang set pieces, screens or cycloramas for projection as productions require. Stage left and right are two drape legs which form wings for stage entrances. The exit to the dressing rooms is by doors behind the wing drapes both stage right and stage left. Behind the upstage drapes there is a narrow crossover space. It is possible to place props tables or similar in the wing space either side of the stage but please advise us of all your backstage storage needs so a plan can be put into place. All backstage space is shared by companies performing **Backstage** on the same day; as such props and set pieces must be packed away as much as possible between shows. The Udderbelly has both good height and weight loading for the rigging of aerial/circus acts. Any rigging setup required will change dependant on the requirements of the shows programmed into the space. An aerial rigging truss will usually be at a height of approximately 7.5m – 8m from the stage floor and capable taking either single or multiple rigging points. It is possible to have a truss leg in one of the stage wings for counterweight operation and tying off of a line going over the stage.

Lafayette is a 4-pole big top situated in Underbelly's Circus Hub site in the middle of the Meadows – an open park in the centre of Edinburgh. The larger and taller of the two venues in Circus Hub, it is capable of housing the largest circus shows at the Fringe. Designed with the most flexible rig with high loading capacity, we try and accommodate the most ambitious companies here.

Stage and Seating

The Lafayette's stage is a 10x11m platform surrounded on three side with raked audience seating in a deep thrust. Situated within the four poles of the Big Top, the low level stage at 150mm from ground level provides an intimate space for performers to keep close to the audience on all sides. The stage surface is black 18mm ply covered with black dance floor.

At the rear of the stage are a pair of black drapes with a split to the centre, which leads directly onto the stage-level set storage area upstage. Upstage left and right are wing drapes allowing for entrances from each side.

The dressing rooms are situated directly outside the tent via the set storage area and an uncovered walkway.

It is possible to place props tables or similar in the wing space either side of the stage but please advise us of all your backstage storage needs so a plan can be put into place.

Backstage, Storage & Dressing Rooms

The backstage storage area is a shared space and your exact requirements must be discussed with the Technical Manager before arrival so that space can be allocated and properly planned. This area is level with the stage, so set pieces will be able to be wheeled directly onto stage. All backstage space is shared by companies performing on the same day; as such props and set pieces must be packed away as much as possible between shows.

Please note there are no laundry facilities on site. If you have particular laundry requirements then please discuss these with the Technical Manager and we can try to help you make arrangements.

A basic shared dressing room unit will be provided with tables, lights and mirrors. Please ensure all of your requirements are discussed with the Technical Manager prior to your arrival.

Rigging

The Lafayette rig incorporates a ground support Prolyte S52 circus rig for all aerial work. This is designed to have the capacity for multiple aerialists and can accommodate loading is multiple places. If you are planning on any rigging, for aerialists or otherwise, please send us as much detail as you can, including a quantity of points, positions drawn on the venue plans, and accurate weight loading required. In terms of weight loading, please detail separately the actual weight loading required for each act, and the safety factor you are taking into consideration.

The Lafayette will carry a basic stock of shackles, spansets, and carabiners, however companies should bring all rigging equipment they require.



Lighting

The venue will provide a general cover with open-white front light. All these lanterns form the venue fixed rig and cannot be re-coloured or focussed by companies. The venues also supplies floor lanterns of 1.2kW fresnels which can be gelled and repositioned between shows. The rig will also feature a selection of both profile and wash moving lights as per the attached rig plan at the end of this document. Control will be by an Avolites Tiger Touch II. Two haze machines with fans will be provided and positioned USL & USR.

Any other lighting required in addition to this can be supplied but the hire cost of these units and any associated dimming will be passed on to companies. Please discuss any requirements with the Company Technical Manager.

A house system consisting of D&B Q7s and Q Subs will be supplied. Control will be by a Yamaha LS9 32 channel desk. The venue will also supply 4 x radio mics and 2x wedge monitors with a 2 way mix. The radio mics can be supplied as either handheld or headset, as required.












	A basic shared dressing room unit will be provided with tables, lights and mirrors. Please ensure all your requirements are discussed with the Technical Manager prior to your arrival.
Rigging	Beauty's rig incorporates a ground support circus rig for all aerial work, however the only position for aerial work is limited to the centre of the tent. The venue incorporates a 3:1 pulley system to allow for aerial equipment to be swapped out during acts quickly with ease. The base of this pulley system is by the side of stage and can be operated by the venue's Stage Manager. Please note that Underbelly venue staff cannot engage in live lifting of aerialists.
	If you are planning on utilising the rigging in the venue, please send us as much detail as you can about the nature of the acts, and accurate weight loading required. In terms of weight loading, please detail separately the actual weight loading required for each act, and the safety factor you are taking into consideration.
	Beauty will carry a basic stock of shackles, spansets, and carabiners, however companies

should bring all rigging equipment required.



The venue will provide a general cover with open-white front light from all sides around the centre stage, and end-on for the Bandstage. All these lanterns form the venue fixed rig and cannot be re-coloured or focussed by companies. The venue also supplies floor lanterns of 12x PAR16 birdies for footlights which can be gelled and repositioned between shows. The rig will also feature a selection of both profile and Lighting wash moving lights as per the attached rig plan at the end of this document. Control will be by an ETC Ion. A haze machine will be provided and positioned USL. Any other lighting required in addition to this can be supplied but the hire cost of these units and any associated dimming will be passed on to companies. Please discuss any requirements with the Company Technical Manager. A house system consisting of D&B T10s and Q Subs will be supplied. Control will be by a Yamaha LS9 16 channel desk. The venue will also supply 2 x radio mics and 2x wedge monitors with a 2 way mix. The radio mics can be supplied as either handheld or headset, as required. We can supply additional wired and wireless radio mics and other sound equipment. Please discuss your requirements with the Technical Manager who can arrange Sound quotes as required. Please note that the venue is a tent. We will do our best to keep noise outside to a minimum, but there is naturally a slight noise bleed. Further to this, there will be a noise limit for performances set and monitored. We will work with companies to find a sensible balance, but this is a requirement of our license with regards to local businesses and residents.



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Please note that these photos reflect the stage in previous years. As detailed above, the stage for 2023 will be circular, at either 2.5 or 4m in diameter (and as reflected in venue plans below), according to show requirements.
